OUR OBJECTIVES:

To provide a free community service to all residents to the city of the southern Shoalhaven or transients, regardless of ethnicity, creed, colour or gender, physical ability or financial status, and assist in the alleviation of sickness, suffering, distress, misfortune, destitution and helplessness.

- Providing where practicable, a direct service to relieve poverty, distress, sickness or helplessness
- Directing people needing help to the most appropriate resources either of a voluntary nature or governmental and where appropriate to advocate on behalf of people to obtain the help and guidance sought.
- Providing and promoting readily available comprehensive sources of information pertaining to community and welfare services and amenities on a wide variety of matters not requiring direct delivery of service
- Use these provisions to empower people to take control of their lives and assist them to gain the skills to meet their own needs

To Identify Community Needs and where possible, establish services to meet those in need.

To co-operate closely with social and community welfare organisations with a view to using available services most effectively and to encourage such organisations to provide outreach services in the southern Shoalhaven.

To engage and co-operate in community education and the public knowledge of community service, needs, resources and civil rights.

To raise, obtain and receive funds or other aid for the purpose of achieving aims of the Association by means of subscriptions, donations, bequests, entertainments or other functions, or by any other means.

To apply the capital and income of the Association and property of the Association or any part thereof (subject to special trusts and to the provisions of the Constitution) to or towards the aims of the Association.

To execute any special trusts in connection with the money or properties held or obtained by the Association (not being inconsistent with the purpose of the Constitution)

To hold all lands, moneys, securities and other property real and personal, belonging to the Association.

To invest any moneys of the Association and hold investments of the same.

To do all such lawful things as are incidental or conducive to the achievement of the foregoing aims or any of them.

To affiliate with such other bodies which have similar aims.
